Essential Functions

1. Oversees the manufacturing processes and procedures in production operations

- 2. Evaluates each station of the production process to maintain optimum efficiency
- 3. Enforces all safety policies on the production floor
- 4. Creates and oversees employee training to increase production, enhance safe operations and ensure profitability
- 5. Inspects products for quality and accuracy prior to shipping
- 6. Maintains communication between management and employees to ensure that necessary policies are understood and followed
- 7. Ensures the flow of resources like raw materials is maintained and that production items are delivered as needed and used properly and efficiently
- 8. Reads, analyzes and interprets technical documents to define problems and established facts.
- 9. Maintains required documentation and submits reports to supervisor
- 10. Complies with all safety policies, practices and procedures. Report all unsafe activities to supervisor and/or Human Resources.

Required Education and Experience

- 1. High school diploma or equivalent required.
- 2. Minimum of four years' experience working in a supervisory role in a manufacturing plant
- 3. Previous experience working in electronics manufacturing preferred.

Work Environment
